Nomination for the 2014-15 Exemplary Program Award

Please accept this as a formal nomination for The COLTS (Community of Leadership and Transfer Success) Academy program at Cañada College for the 2014-15 Exemplary Program Award.

The COLTS Academy program is in direct alignment with this year's award theme as it's designed to improve student success and retention for first-year high school to community college students. Students who recently graduated from high schools in San Mateo County were selected to participate in a free 4-day program that provided students the opportunity to:

- 1. **Connect** meet Cañada Faculty, staff and fellow students, as well as connect with special programs (EOPS, TRIO, A2B, BTO, Outreach)
- **2. Lead** learn about leadership opportunities at Cañada College as well as how to be leaders in their educational journey
- **3. Succeed** walk away with a Transfer Success Portfolio equipped with tools and resources for college success, as well as connect with counseling and the financial aid office

COLTS Academy was held from Monday, July 28th to Thursday July 31, 2014 and featured fun and interactive workshops, a powerful mix of peer leaders who were mentors-for-the-day, access to free academic resources, and an offered an amazing opportunity for first-year students to get a head start on their academic career at Cañada.

This effort was a true campus collaborative as the steering committee consisted of members from across student and academic support services; ASCC, BTO, TRIO, STEM, A2B, Transfer Center, Career Center, Counseling, EOPS/CalWORKs, Learning Center, Outreach, Financial Aid, Welcome Center. We also included faculty in providing workshops; Michael Hoffman, The Growth Mindset.

We now have an effective model in place that serves first-year transitioning high school students to the community college that centers on collaboration among student and academic support services, classified and faculty involvement, utilizing peer mentoring as a key factor to connect new students to the campus, and can be replicated at any community college. This model includes evaluation, assessment and budget.

Program Evaluation Report:

I. Who participated?

- 84% of participants attended all four days of the COLTS Academy (Table 1).
- 68% of participants are women.
- 55% of participants are Hispanic.

II. What did the participants learn?

 Overall, after attending the COLTS Academy, participants felt more connected to other students, staff, and faculty at Cañada College. New students reported significant increases in their connectedness to other students, staff and faculty after the COLTS Academy (Table 2).

1. Current students were those who indicated on the evaluation form that they were existing Canada students or have completed a transfer portfolio before COLTS Academy.

- Participants reported gaining more leadership skills after participating in the COLTS Academy (overall mean =4.0), even though many reported having some leadership skill prior to the COLTS Academy (overall mean=3.1).
- Participants reported having more awareness about the services and programs available at Cañada College after participating in the COLTS Academy.
- The degree of having a complete transfer portfolio increased after participation in the COLTS Academy.
- For new students, the connections made and information gained were significant before and after participation in the COLTS Academy.
- 100% of the new-student and 3 out of 4 current-student participants would recommend COLTS Academy to a friend.
