## From Moodle 2.9 to Moodle 3.0—What to expect?



WebAccess is actually Moodle, and we are being upgraded to version 3.0 on 10 August 2016. While the overall functionality will be similar, there have been some changes and improvements. Below are some of the changes that have been made.


One really great site is here: <a href="https://docs.moodle.org/30/en/New\_features">https://docs.moodle.org/30/en/New\_features</a> While it is not exhaustive in the list of changes, the site does list the most important changes. Specifically, it details the new quiz options—Cloze passage quizzes, drag and drop question/answer option, both in text and picture format, as well as knowing when a file was updated/uploaded.

Other changes to the website version include:

- Mobile app has increased functionality. You can now do the following activities/functions:
  - o choice
  - chat
  - survey
  - search courses
  - self-enroll
- Messages: Allow users to delete personal messages
- Editing modules: Instead of clicking the 'gear' icon, you click on edit.



Editing an assignment: Instead of a list of icons to choose from, you simply click 'Edit' for the
assignment. Then choose the element you wish to change; if it's various settings of the
assignment, then click 'Edit settings'.



Gradebook: Renamed 'Categories and items' to 'Gradebook setup' and add link



- ATTO Toolbar—major upgrades: ATTO is still the default toolbar, but it's been greatly upgraded:
  - o 'Insert special characters' and 'Insert equation' have now been integrated into the toolbar.
  - Table editor—to customize your tables
  - Still can't change text color on the ATTO toolbar.
