TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) is a program funded by the United States Department of Education. Our goal is to provide an academic, social, and personal support system for firstgeneration, low-income, and/or students with disabilities, to assist them with certificate and degree college requirements, the transfer process, and to motivate them towards successful completion of their college education.


Services

Impact



TRIO supports students who identify as Latinx (49%) and AANAPI (16%) at our college.

TRIO Students must qualify as Low Income (76%), First Generation in College (81%), or have a Learning or Physical Disability (13%) to participate.

Through well qualified staff, who also come from the BIPOC community and identify with one or more of our eligibility requirements, we are able to provide representation and mentorship to students that are Latinx, AANAPI, and Black identifying.

SAOs & Stats

95% of current TRIO students completed an SEP, indicating a Major.

75% of W1 participants & 88% of W2 participants indicated they gained tools to counter systems of oppression.
