Requirements:

- Complete 60 transferrable units by the end of Spring term prior to Fall admission
 - Complete the Golden four Courses with grade C or higher:
 - Written Communication
 - Oral Communication
 - Critical Thinking /Second year of English
 - A Transferrable Math Course
 - Earn Minimum GPA in Transferrable courses
 - Earn minimum GPA of 2.0/non-residents 2.4 (Last year average GPA of admitted student was 3.3)
 - Complete major course requirements (www.ASSIST.org)
 - Complete 39 units of CSU GE breadth. (except the high unit majors) - see the CSU GE worksheet in the catalog, Transfer Center webpage, or ASSIST.org for list of transfer courses
 - MEET with a counselor
 - Attend the Transfer Center Workshops
 - Apply to California State Universities by the deadline

Transfer Degree (AA-T/AS-T)

In accordance with the new initiative, Senate Bill 1440, Cañada College currently offers 8 Transfer Degrees, for the AA-T/AS-T. Students who are interested in transferring to California State Universities (CSU) may benefit from completing one of these degrees when applying to CSU campuses. It is crucial for students to contact a counselor to discuss and plan for this degree as soon as they select their major.

AA-T/AS-T Degrees Offered at Cañada College

AA-T/AS-T Degree Requirements:

Need total 60 units that includes:

- Major Courses
- CSU GE breadth or IGETC
- File a AA-T/AS-T degree petition by the deadline
- Apply to CSU by the deadline
- Obtain a degree verification letter from Transfer Center

Benefits:

You will receive an AS-T/AA-T degree at the same time of completing the CSU GE certification, and transfer requirements

- You receive local CSU admission priority
- You will be guaranteed admission to a CSU Campus
- You get a GPA index bump
- Spring Admission to selected CSU campuses (see www.CSUMentor.edu), and for non-impacted majors
- Facilitate the transfer process to a CSU campus where there is no articulation for major courses.

Admission to UC

Requirements:

- Complete 60 transferrable units by the end of Spring term prior to Fall admission
 - Complete the following courses grade C or higher:
 - Written Communication
 - Critical Thinking /Second year of English
 - A Transferrable Math Course
 - Earn Minimum GPA in Transferrable courses
 - Earn minimum GPA of 2.4/ non-resident 2.8 (Last year average GPA of admitted student was 3.5)
 - Complete major course requirements (www.ASSIST.org)
 - Complete IGETC (except the high unit majors) - see the IGETC worksheet in the catalog, Transfer Center webpage, or ASSIST.org for list of transfer courses
 - MEET with a counselor
 - Attend the Transfer Center Workshops
 - Apply to University of California by the deadline

Application will be open on October 1 for students to have enough time to complete the application.

TAG: The Transfer Admission Guarantee allows students to sign a contract with participant universities to ensure their admission. To be eligible for Transfer Admission Agreements, students must have successfully completed a minimum of 30 transferable units and meet the university's admission requirements for specific programs.
