How to Apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must apply online at www.csumentor.org. If you are applying to multiple campuses, you must submit one application to each campus. You need to report your transfer GPA, courses in progress, planned courses, and Golden Four courses The CSU campuses communicate via e-mail only; it is important to have an EMAIL ADDRESS. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply online at UC campuses PATHWAY Website: http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/index.html Only one application is necessary to apply to multiple UC campuses!! The UC campuses will communicate via email, therefore, it is important to have an EMAIL ADDRESS and check it on a regular basis once you submit the application. In your application, you must provide a list of <u>all</u> courses, your accomplishments, and respond to 2 prompts within 1000 words.
When to Apply	<p>Winter Quarter 2017: <u>June 1 – 30, 2016</u></p> <p>Spring Semester or Quarter 2017: <u>August 1 – 30, 2016</u></p> <p>Fall Semester or Quarter 2017: <u>October 1 – November 30, 2016</u></p>	<p>UC campuses are on quarter system except UC Berkeley and UC Merced.</p> <p>Fall 2017: <u>November 1 – 30, 2016</u> UC Application will be available on August 1, 2016</p> <p>All UC campuses are closed for Spring 2017, except UC Merced The Spring 2017 application period for UC Merced is July 1-31.</p>
Application Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The <u>application fee is \$55 per application</u>. You must include the payment of fees once you have submitted your application on-line; otherwise it will not be processed. <i>(You may pay by check, money order, or credit card.)</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The <u>application fee for resident students is \$70 and for non-resident students is \$80 per campus</u>. If you apply to more than one campus, you must pay an additional \$70/\$80 for each campus you select. You must include the payment of fees with your application; otherwise it will not be processed. <i>(You may pay by check, money order, or credit card.)</i>
	<p>Fee Waivers: The application fees (<i>up to 4 campuses for CSU and 4 campuses for UC</i>) will be waived for qualified. There are two ways to obtain a fee waiver which needs to be submitted with the application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Fill-out the fee waiver form online EOPS Community College Students can obtain a fee waiver authorization from the EOPS Office. 	
Acknowledgement	<p>You will receive acknowledgment from the campus to which you applied. Read this notification carefully and follow the instructions on how to check your application status on-line.</p> <p>Each campus will provide you with a username and password to check your status via their website. You will also be notified, via your account, if additional documents are required.</p>	<p>As soon as you submit your application, you'll receive an e-mail confirming it has been successfully filed. Four to five weeks later, you should get another acknowledgment from the UC Undergraduate Application Processing Service confirming your application and fees were received. If you do not receive this acknowledgment, contact the processing service at ucinfo@ucapplication.net, or call 800-523-2048.</p>
	<p>Please check the email that you provided them and respond to their request(s) immediately.</p>	
Application Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will receive notification of your admission status via email. They may ask to send an official transcript by mail to reflect your final grades for fall term. Each campus has different dates to receive the fall grades. You must confirm the acceptance of their offer by completing Student Intend to Register (SIR) by May 1st. When you are admitted to the campus, you will receive information about orientation, registration, and other activities for new students. Arrange to take the English Placement Test (EPT) as soon as possible. The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with Spring</u> grades, test scores, and any other documentation is <u>July 15th</u>. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will be required to submit an APPLICATION UPDATE form on-line (www.universityofcalifornia.edu/admissions/appupdate) which will include the submission of your fall grades and confirm your coursework for the spring term, and to provide the UC campuses with your most current academic information. Place close attention to the deadlines for submitting the updates as each campus may have different deadline. They will notify you of their decision between Mid-March and the end of April You must confirm the acceptance of their offer by completing Student Intend to Register (SIR) by June 1st. The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with spring</u> grades, test scores, and any other documentation is <u>July 1st</u>.
	<p>Not updating your application and/or responding to their requests will cause your application to be withdrawn.</p>
