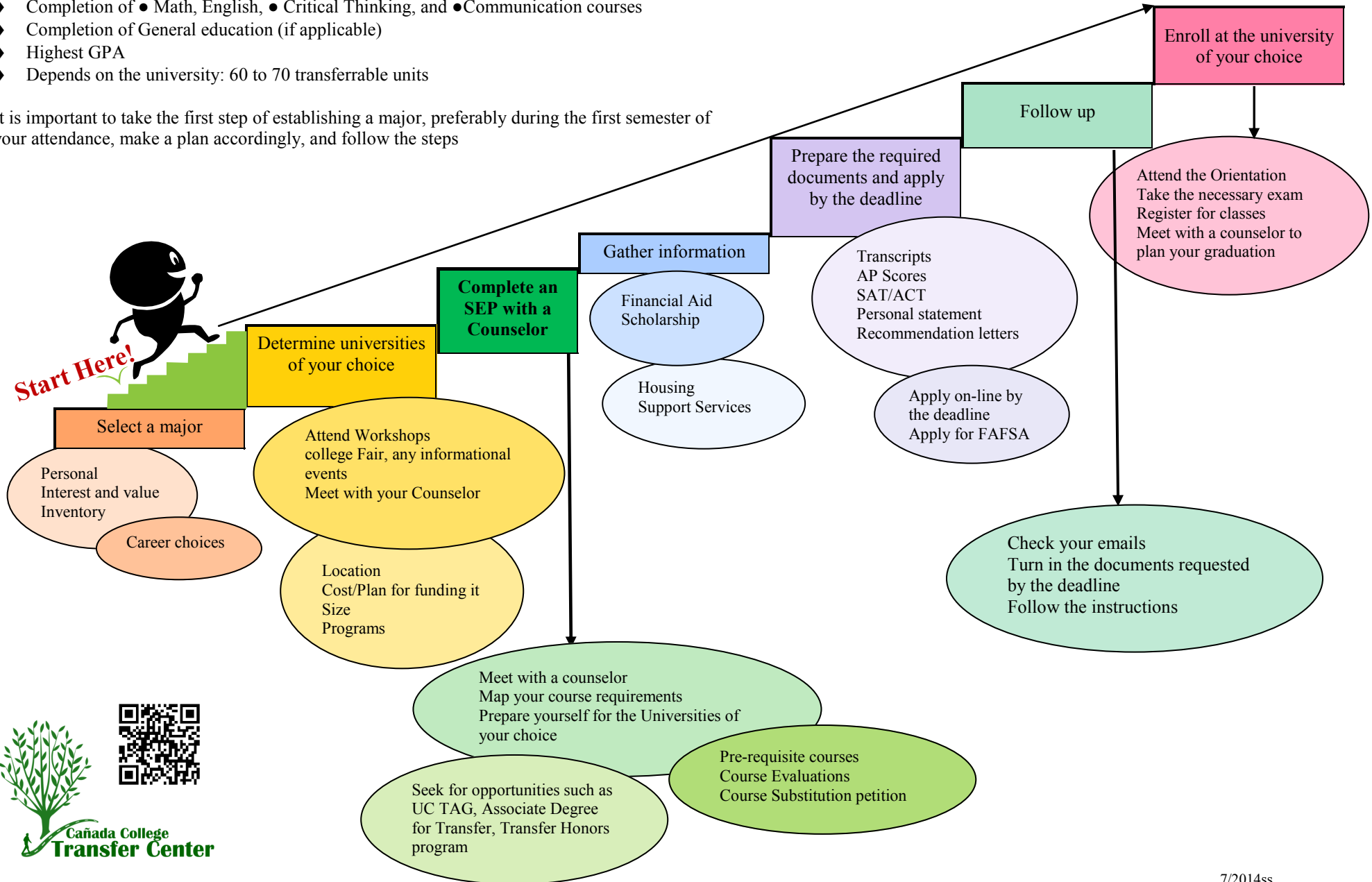


Transfer Plan

The universities' selection criteria is mainly based on:

- ◆ Completion of pre-requisite courses for a major
- ◆ Completion of ● Math, English, ● Critical Thinking, and ● Communication courses
- ◆ Completion of General education (if applicable)
- ◆ Highest GPA
- ◆ Depends on the university: 60 to 70 transferrable units

It is important to take the first step of establishing a major, preferably during the first semester of your attendance, make a plan accordingly, and follow the steps



Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) to UC

In addition to the articulation agreements with universities, Cañada College has Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) with all UC Campuses that offer this opportunity to transfer students.

- UC, Davis
- UC, Irvine
- UC, Merced
- UC, Riverside
- UC, Santa Barbara
- UC, Santa Cruz

To be eligible for TAG students must have:

- Completed at least 30 transferable semester units prior to the term applying for TAG
- Met the GPA requirements for each campus and each program
- Met the major course requirements
- 60 semester units by the end of Spring term prior to fall admission to UC

The TAG application submission dates:

September 1st — 30th

What is a Transfer and Transfer Program?

Transfer is to prepare students for four-year universities by offering transferable courses and services. Preparing for transfer to a four-year university involves completing required lower division courses in the major and general education.

What are the transferable courses? Courses that are acceptable by other universities and may be used toward a degree at four-year universities. These courses are comparable to courses at baccalaureate level.

This partnership allows Cañada College students to continue their University education at Cañada College while pursuing a bachelor degree in the following majors:

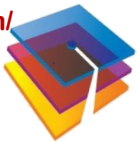
