The Academic Senate Governing Council reviewed and discussed the Spring 2015 Hiring Proposals and prioritized the hiring proposals, based upon the content of the written proposals, the college-wide presentations, and the metrics appended below.

PT-FTEF is the amount of FTEF being taught by adjunct faculty. It is calculated by subtracting the actual number of full-timers from the total available course offerings. The number of possible new full-timers that could be supported by the department is less than, or equal to, this number.

Fill Rate is calculated based upon actual enrollments at census compared to the maximum enrollment.
