- III. Open Education Week 2024 Report (5 minutes)
 - a. Recordings and materials are available on the <u>SMCCCD Open Ed Week webpage</u>.
 - b. Great turn-outs, both live and in registrations! (Materials and recording links were sent to all registrants.)
 - c. If you have a moment, check out the Keynote discussion from Monday: Jasmine Roberts-Crews and the SCOPE Framework. (Kudos to our CSM colleagues who led that webinar!)
 - d. Diana led a great discussion and review of Creative Commons licensing, which should help to demystify CC and encourage folks to use it. We had attendees from within and outside of the District!
 - e. The tabling in the Grove was ok, but Jacky Ip came up with some great ideas earlier: get Peer Mentors, Retention Specialists and the student rep to TAS involved; do the tabling more regularly and in areas where there is already visibility. (Skyline has a standard College Hour, which is Wednesdays at noon; Cañada used to do something like this, but it stopped many years ago.)
 - i. Katie was looking to get more tabling anyway, so she and Sarah will work on strategies to bring this forward. Perhaps even see if ASCC wants to spear-head tabling in the walkways of the Learning Center, other key places, as a way to connect student reps to college bodies with the rest of the campus community.
 - ii. Anniqua thought that connecting tabling and outreach to various groups could be a way to engage with faculty and staff more, to generally spread the word about ZTC/LTC courses and how the help students.
- IV. <u>ZTC/OER Data from PRIE</u> (30 minutes; Information/Discussion)
 - a. Discussion about the data, next steps
 - i. Slides were updated to include information and questions
 - ii. Sarah has asked PRIE for specific data from Fall 2022-Spring 2023 to see if there are changes in the data once SMCCCD started funding ZTC work (Free College Initiative funds from the Board).
 - iii. Sarah talked with Ame Maloney at Skyline about the data; they're on par with what Skyline has seen in the past.
 - iv. Key questions that need further analysis:
 - 1. Is the enrollment data independent of ZTC/LTC marking?
 - 2. Could we follow up with ZTC/LTC students to see if the outreach is working?
 - v. Make sure to connect with Marketing/Outreach, especially Mayra Arellano and the Promise folks. (Sarah and Katie are working on marketing pieces and are going to connect with Marketing soon.)
 - vi. Sarah was asked to bring some or all of this presentation to DEAC, Technology

Committee, IPC, in addition to bringing it to Academic Senate and PBC.

- b. Sarah applied to present this at the Online Teaching Conference in Long Beach in June...and was accepted!
 - i. She'll also apply to present this at Cal-OER in August and the Open Education Conference in October, once those Calls For Proposals are opened.
