Get off campus! Have a great theme! Don't let Admin or Faculty dictate your objectives for the event.





# SOME INSTITUTIONS HAD PROGRAMS THAT MIGHT BENEFIT CAÑADA INCLUDING:

- Vice Chancellor funding additional Classified Staff to attend CLI
- AFT funding additional Classified Staff to attend CLI
- Professional Growth Awards, for completing courses and certificates
- Professional Professional Development Programs (PPDP) to support advancement from within (i.e. how to become a professor)
- Increasing Flex Day trainings to 3 days of workshops that specifically emphasize skill building for Classified, called ClassiCon at that institution

# OTHER CLASSIFIED AREN'T SO LUCKY

- Managers not allowing release time for Professional Development
- No institutionalized Professional Development plan
- Flex days not including Classified Staff input or content directed towards them
- Little to no organizational leadership efforts or continuity to support Classified Professional development
- Lack of Mentoring or career advancement at their institution
- A shared pot of money with Faculty where there is no equitable access or disbursement of funds
- A lack of consistency between schools within the same District
- Classified Senate used as a fundraising entity, especially for an institution where no PD funds are issued to Classified from their District
- Derision from Faculty and Managers for implementing a 9 + 1 plan similar to those in place for Faculty and Students

#### CONFERENCES


You can apply for up to \$1,000 for first time attendance to a professional development conference of your choice.
