Proctorio Trial – Ray Lapuz		<ul> <li>There is an app integrated with Canvas. Then install into courses.</li> <li>Works with quizzes in Canvas only, not through other LTIs (publishers).</li> <li>Pencil/paper exams do not work well with Proctorio.</li> <li>Use to use ProctorU (which had an actual person watching the student take the exam). Proctorio creates a video for viewing.</li> <li>Set settings: webcam, screen, not allowed to copy and paste, no dual monitor and etc. Can also check their id with their face.</li> <li>Provided an option, if students do not want to be</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>Color coding does not mean anything. Must click on each source to see what it is really trying to tell you. What is being highlighted is not necessarily the issue.</li> <li>Colors are degrees of confidence for the source.</li> <li>Not user friendly.</li> <li>When you click on the source, as a whole, it would take about a minute+ to load.</li> <li>Many really like turnitin.com (although it was down periodically during the summer).</li> <li>Canvas is not compatible with turnitin.com</li> <li>DE Center create standardized screenshots regarding submitting to turnitin through Canvas.</li> </ul>
