
What is Kurzweil 3000?

Accessing Kurzweil 3000




- Kurzweil can be accessed from any smartphone, tablet, or computer with an internet connection, at <u>kurzweil3000.com</u>
- O The DRC Alt-Media staff will create a username and password for approved Kurzweil users
- O Note! Contact the DRC Alt-Media staff if you need assistance with logging in

The Kurzweil Universal Library

- Logging into Kurzweil will direct you to the <u>Universal Library</u> – the document cloud where your textbooks will be uploaded
- Your uploaded books will be listed by title in your private folder
- Each book will be separated into 10 page files, and each file will be labeled by section and page range

- 1. Click on folder with YOUR NAME
- 2. Click on **PRIVATE** folder
- 3. Click on the **BOOK** you want to read
- 4. Click on the **SECTION** you want to read
