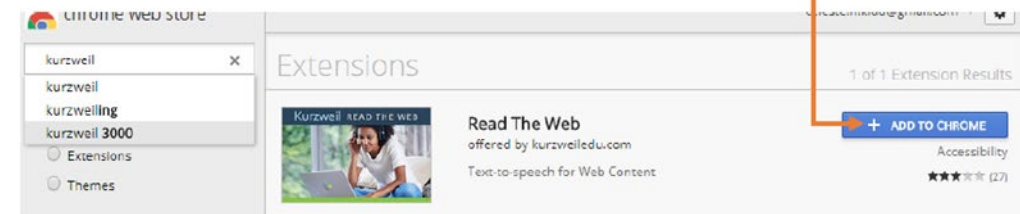
How to Access Read the Web

- Kurzweil Read the Web is an extension found in Google Chrome that lets you use Kurzweil for internet content (including Canvas)
- Make sure you are signed into your student email account before you add Read the Web
- Follow these instructions to get started

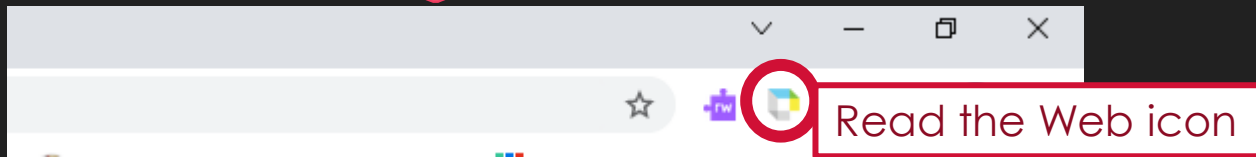


★ Google Chrome is required ★

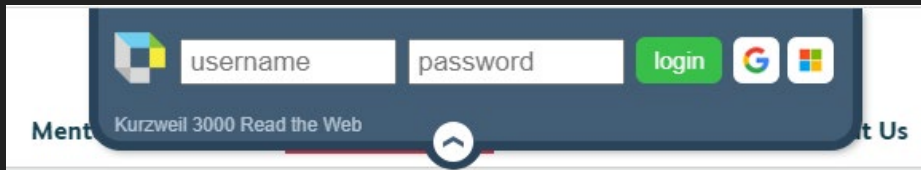
1. Go to the **Chrome Web Store**
2. Search for **KURZWEIL READ THE WEB**
3. Click on the icon to **add the extension** to Chrome



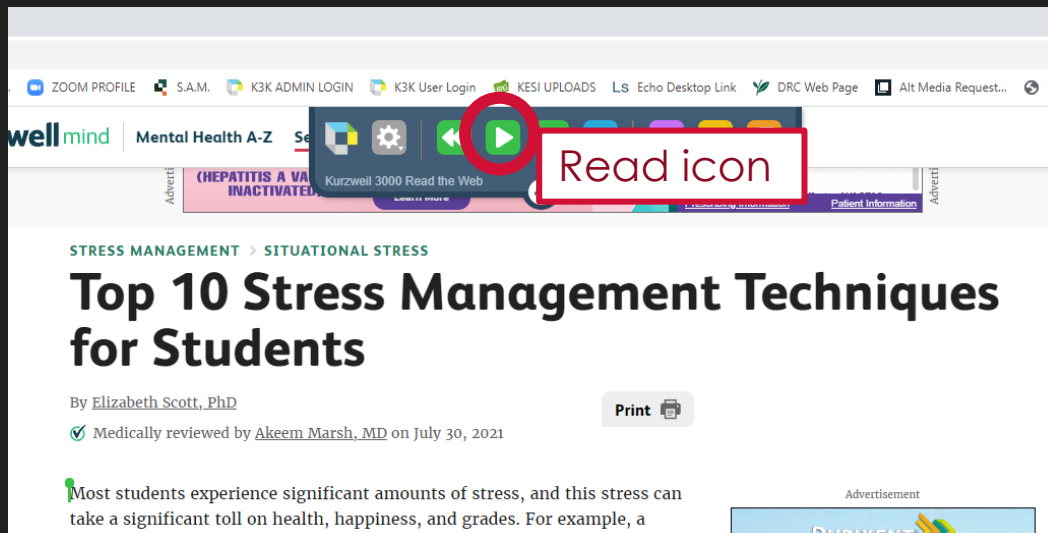
Using Read the Web



- In Google Chrome, go to the desired web page



- Locate and click on the **Read the Web** icon in the upper right corner of your window (to the right of your URL bar)



- Use your Kurzweil username and password to log in
- Place your cursor on the desired text, and click the **Read** icon to begin reading
