


Purpose Statement

❑ **Begin Assessment Cycle:** Assess first three years of program.

Since the Fall of 2023, BAM has served 55 unique male-identified students

- AANHPI: 12%

- Black: 6%

- LatinX: 65%

- MultiRacial: 8%

- White: 9%

- **Fall-to-Fall Persistence:**

- 2023-24: 64%

- 2024-25: 64%

- **Overall GPA: 2.76**
