Will be using information from Skyline and CSM to 'learn from their mistakes'. Skyline will be presenting at Senate on Thurs. Dec. 6th 2:45pm in room 2-10. Opportunity to hear from Skyline and use the information to form Guided Pathways in a way that works best for Cañada. New Faculty participants: Chris Rico (Counseling) and Martin Partlan (STEM). Workforce/Business and Social Sciences Faculty in process of being confirmed. ACTION: Questions from Skyline Dec 6th Senate presentation to be shared with Steering Committee. Student Voices-Three focus groups completed. Next two focus groups will be using students from a hybrid/career course. Currently synthesizing data. Identified student presenters for flex day to report what was shared and not necessarily what should be done. The student data will then be used to inform pathway and BPA work. It was mentioned that Skyline noticed a gap between the student experience and current process. It's important that the Subgroups share all information that may impede other subgroups. Business Process Analysis- Started semester anticipating using Inside Track but now, will be using the District CRM to collect needed data and streamline processes. Other questions arose from last meeting such as discussion regarding ‘What is Guided Pathways at Cañada College’, ‘Who owns Guided Pathways’, ‘What are the gaps in communication after a student applies to the college’ etc... Discussion ensued about what information is included in emails to students. At LaGuardia Community College, student profiles viewed through their CRM system consists of the student’s picture, SEP, class schedule, classes missed, class progress, counselor/instructor meetings, and extracurricular activities. Promise has been meeting with District PRIE to build out the logic model for SMCCCD’s CRM. Recommendation to make Early Alert an ‘All-Semester’ alert. Questions about progress reports, where do they go? While we wait for the CRM to be implemented, we can use the SAP tool which would allow us to obtain student data and email reports. Discussion ensued around ‘Student Success Teams’ which consists of a cross-functional group who would be given a case load of students. This results in everyone on campus knowing all operations. Another example was mentioned from CUNY ASAP in use of Success Teams and use of Peer Mentors.</p> <p>ACTION: Research implementation of Student Success Teams.
