What is Guided Pathways and how does it differ from a Strategic Enrollment Plan?</li> <li>It was noted that Guided Pathways is similar to a Strategic Enrollment Plan. M. Wiley provided highlights from the Guided Pathways workshop in San Jose: <ul> <li>Guided Pathways should be a product of Sustainable Decision Making.</li> <li>It is a Campus-Wide initiative that impacts everyone.</li> <li>The development and implementation of Guided Pathways should be closely tied with the College's Shared Governance Process.</li> <li>Students should be involved in each workgroup.</li> <li>Should be data driven.</li> <li>Instructional Pathways should be combined with Student Support activities.</li> <li>Need to identify long-term funding source.</li> <li>Guided Pathways helps to break down barriers to connection with the campus community.</li> </ul> </li> <li>G. Morin mentioned the STEM Academy which could potentially be used as a template for the Academic Pathways Subgroup. The STEM Academy cohort consists of: <ul> <li>First-year students (mainly, 2018 high school graduates)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
