

ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

Brooke White

After a long career in the Fashion industry, Brooke White wanted to try something new. She always loved art, architecture and interior design, so in January of 2021, Brooke signed up for classes in the Interior Design program at Canada. "My first classes were Color with Denny, and Intro to Interior Design with Elsa. I had so much fun learning about design and I realized it pulled together a lot of my life interests - I was hooked!". Brooke completed her coursework for an AS degree in Interior Design last December. She plans to graduate this May. When thinking about how to start her career, Brooke decided to move to the Palm Springs area where she found a lot of opportunities for work. Through an introduction from a friend, Brooke got an informational interview at an architecture firm that specializes in residential and hospitality design.



She pulled together some of her work from school into a presentation she could show on her iPad. She also spent time thoroughly reading every page of the architecture firm's website, paying attention to the small details of how they told their story so that she could weave in comments during her informational interview. She noticed that the company focused on gorgeous environments but they mostly were neutral in color. "I pulled together a bunch of images from Architectural Digest and Dwell that gave an indication of what I might want to do as a designer if I were creating interiors for the spaces they designed. My choices had more color than what they were showing on their website but still kept their ethos. I thought, what the heck, I have nothing to lose so I will show them what they could possibly do with interiors that would compliment their beautiful architecture." Two weeks after the interview, Brooke was offered a job as an interior designer.

After working for the firm for eight months, Brooke decided to leave to open her own firm. "I learned a lot and got my feet wet in actual Interior Design. However, I realized that since this was my second career, I wanted more flexibility than working a solid 40-hour work week." Brooke opened Brooke White Interiors shortly thereafter. "The first thing I did was set up an Instagram account (@brookewhiteinteriors) and posted an image of a fireplace surround I did for my own home." Two weeks later, she got a call from someone who saw the image and was re-designing their kitchen and living room. More jobs have followed, coming from referrals from friends or other designers she networked with who have too much work and can't take on more. She is working on a website and is participating in a Show House opening in October 2023 at The Vintage Club in Indian Wells, Ca. Brooke is designing the Powder Room. Brooke loved her time at Canada - learning from all the talented teachers as well as other students. "My favorite part of the program was seeing the projects my fellow students produced. There is so much talent in our program. I can't wait to see where everyone ends up and what they dream up!". She also served as Secretary on the ID Club Board, making great connections she will take with her. Brooke's advice for post-graduation? "Be clear on your own story. What do you like? Where does your inspiration come from? Weave your story into the story of the firm you want to work for. Be sure they know you appreciate their design philosophy by demonstrating that in any written or oral communications you have with the company."
