IPC GOALS FOR 2017-18

Goals left as "in progress" after the 2016-17 academic year:

- Provide recommendations to Academic Senate regarding Instructional Program Review (IPR) questions and process.
- Revise IPR's rubric, if needed.
- Create exemplary list of IPR sections for program review authors provide examples of well written IPR documents, examples of how disciplines have used the program review process to improve programs, etc.
- Review Request for Reassignment Proposal (RRP) process and make any necessary recommendations to AS.

New Goals for 2017-18 academic year (as per IPC minutes from 9/15/17):

- Program Mitigation and Revitalization IPC should play a role in leading the conversation about program creation and program improvement.
- Participatory Governance Manual (see page 24) New Program Development Process: IPC proposed the addition to the line in the above section of the Participatory Governance Manual so Step 1 would read: "The idea for a new general fund (Fund 1) program is identified and a proposal developed. IPC is the primary group to provide a forum for new program feedback." This is a proposal for a revision to the New Program Development Process.
- IPC members should be provided with training for Assessment tools (SPOL and TracDAT) to be included during one meeting this year.
- IPC should be doing some research of new programs occurring at other institutions including finding new opportunities, bringing them to Senate and suggesting exploratory committees.
