GRADUATION APPLICATION PROCESS



PREVIOUS GRADUATION APPLICATION PROCESS (PRE-4/28/25)

Application Initiation

Students met with academic counselors who submitted graduation applications on their behalf.

Initial Review and Audit

Admissions Office reviewed applications using DegreeWorks POS audits to verify course completion and progress.

Petition Evaluation and Notification

Students not meeting requirements were notified of petition denials after evaluators checked counseling notes and emails.

Final Evaluation and Record Update

Evaluation is finalized after grades are posted



NEW GRADUATION APPLICATION PROCESS (POST-4/28/25)

Online Application Submission

Students can now submit graduation applications directly through their WebSMART accounts.

Programs of Study Update

Students must update and declare all desired Programs of Study before applying to graduate in WebSMART.

Application Limits and Support

Students may submit up to **five** applications; additional applications require contacting Admissions, with support available from multiple offices.

Confirmation and Resources

Upon submission, confirmation emails are sent to both students and Admissions, with detailed instructions and FAQs online.


SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

Data-Driven Enhancements


Analyze usage data and student experiences to guide future system improvements.
