HMSV 265: FAMILY DEVELOPMENT PORTFOLIO, PART 1. CRN: 89340



These classes are 2 of 4 classes needed to obtain "National Family Development Credentials". The other 2 classes (HMSV 264 and 266) are offered in the spring.

HMSV 262, 265, 264, and 266 are the curriculum for the University of Connecticut (UCON) National Family Development Credentials Program (NFDC). Students can achieve the NFDC in one year; 2-semesters. These same classes are required for an A.S. Degree, and most of the Human Services Certificates offered by Cañada College. All units are transferable for 4-year schools.
