Important Program Review Updates

As we prepare for the upcoming Program Review Cycle, I wanted to remind the campus community of some important updates. This year's Program Review process will be conducted in TracDat – not SPOL. The <u>TracDat Portal</u> is now open and you may log in at any time. There is also a new Program Review timeline:

- 1. New position requests are due on October 12 (forms are available <u>here</u>);
- 2. Program Review and all resource requests are due in TracDat on November 1;

3. Please note: programs in an "off cycle" year should complete the questions under "Annual Update" and then progress to the "Objectives, Action Planning, and Resource Requests" section in the Trac Dat nav bar.

New Position Proposal Starts October 12th

It is time for the College community to begin the position proposal process. Proposals should be submitted no later than October 12th, to Deans/supervising administrators. Deans submit final proposals to VPI/VPSS, then they are posted to the PBC website. Presentations and Discussion are scheduled for Oct. 30- Nov. 1. The Planning and Budgeting Council (PBC) has set aside three sessions to accommodate the number of position proposals. You can see the complete timeline here.

Accreditation

PBC voted this week to make the following broad topic for our focus area for the next 3-4 years: Identify barriers to student entry, persistence, and completion and address them systematically.

This is a critical step in writing our Institutional Self-Evaluation Report (ISER) which now requires that we write a *Quality Focus Essay* identifying the projects we will pursue that are vital to the long-term improvement of student learning and achievement over a multi-year period. We will explore and refine this topic, and the related projects, on Flex Day next week, October 10, when we will discuss this as a campus community.
