Amazon Web Services (AWS)

Cañada College is currently developing a Cloud Computing Certificate in partnership with Amazon Web Services (AWS). This certificate will provide students with the industry-standard skills necessary to understand and develop applications for the cloud, including hardware and software requirements, storage and database management, and security. Based on curriculum already successfully implemented at Santa Monica College, this certificate is being developed by local faculty in computer science to provide students the skills they need to either transfer into a four-year degree or enter directly into the workforce. With an ambitious target of Fall 2019 for our first course offerings, keep an eye out for new computer science courses in the cloud!
