We appreciate you flexibility and willingness to work with a new system on a much shorter timeframe. Here are a few updates on where we are now in our Program Review process.

### Program Review Feedback

Due to IPC's Program Review Feedback meeting being cancelled in the fall due to the Paradise Fires, IPC has rescheduled their Program Review Feedback meeting for Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup> from 9am-11am. All are welcome to attend and breakfast will be provided. SSPC and APC have already provided their feedback which is being posted on the Program Review website.

Programs will receive their IPC Feedback Forms from their Deans via email before February 15<sup>th</sup>. All feedback forms will also be posted to the each program's <u>Program Review web page</u> (click on your program name in the Instructional Program Review schedule to get to your program's page).

## Resource Request Allocation

We are on track for the VPA to bring a funding proposal for the Program Review resource requests to PBC by April 30<sup>th</sup> as outlined in our new <u>Program Review timeline</u>. Currently, the Deans, VPs and the President are reviewing their departments' resource requests to see what can be funded this fiscal year. Requests for resources in the next fiscal year will be considered once VPA Mendoza receives the College's revenue projections from the District in March. 
## Program Review Presentations Coming—Mark Your Calendars

# Athletic Director Speaks at Alma Mater


