Summary of Program Review Resource Allocation

This year's Program Review process allowed for one-time resource requests for the current fiscal year as well as one-time and on-going Personnel and Resource requests for *next year's* fiscal year budget (2019-20).

The funding available this year for one-time resource needs will be shared directly with Deans and their respective Vice Presidents by May 24.

As to the requests made for resources in *next year's* budget (2019-20), the following information was shared with PBC on April 17, 2019:

CWA Counseling (Full Time, Tenure Track) \$126,235

Director of Planning, Wellness & Kinesiology (Interim/Temporary thru June 2021) (Salary & Benefits) \$186,394

Funded on a One-time Basis:

KAD Department Program Services Coordinator (Salary & Benefits) \$108,356

On Hold due to Funding Constraints:

-SparkPoint Office Assistant II: Position is on hold due to funding constraints.

-Office Assistant II: Position is on hold due to funding constraints.

Resource Requests:

Allocation of Resource Request funds is on hold until the submission of the FY 2019-20 Final Budget *or* the completion of the assessment of the Learning Resource Center (LRC). We are currently in the process of assessing the *Learning Resource Center* services in light of current AB 705 requirements as well as eminent termination of critical grant funding (GANAS and ESO grants).
