
TODAY: Critical Conversation: Community Read

Getting Ready for Program Review!

On behalf of PBC, SSPC, IPC and Academic Senate, the <u>Program Review Work Group</u> has been meeting regularly throughout the Spring semester in preparation for the 2021-2022 Program Review Cycle, which begins in the Fall. The purpose of our Work Group is to help coordinate and support an effective program review process each year across instructional, administrative, and student services programs. We wanted to share with you a few updates before we all leave for the summer, so that you can be prepared for submitting program review in the Fall.

Timeline Updates

A few small changes have been made to the <u>Program Review timeline</u>, making *program review data and resources available in mid-June* and clarifying the role of the Dean's/ VP's feedback in the process.

2021-2022 Due Dates

- Submit your complete Comprehensive Program Review or Annual Update, and resources requests if needed, before October 15, 2021.
- Deans and VPs complete feedback of all program review materials and send out before October 29, 2021.
- Review your Dean's/VP's feedback and incorporate it into your program review before November 5, 2021.

New Cycle (Are you up for program review this Fall?) & Guides

There have been changes to our program review cycle, so be sure to double check the <u>Administrative</u>, <u>Instructional</u>, or <u>Student Services</u> Program Review Schedules to see if your program is up for comprehensive program review in the 2021-2022 cycle. Note that if you're not up for comprehensive program review in the 2021-2022 cycle and would like to request resources, you will need to submit an Annual Update.

Remember to refer to our <u>program review guides</u> if you have questions about accessing Improve (TracDat) or submitting program review.
