25-Year Service Awards Reception

On Monday, I had the honor of recognizing two special Cañadians who are celebrating 25 Years of Service with SMCCCD, Althea Kippes and Mario Peña.

Althea Kippes, Associate Professor, Business, Design & Workforce Division
Althea Kippes began as an adjunct faculty member at Cañada College teaching
Environmental Law in Cañada's Paralegal Program. She later taught in the Paralegal
Program at Skyline College. In August 2019, she became a full-time Business faculty
member at Cañada College.

Althea's life was completely transformed by attending community college and then transferring to U.C. Berkeley's Haas School of Business. She knew as a community college student that she would someday return to teach at a community college as a way to give something back for all of the benefits she had received. She came to Cañada for the Paralegal Program and because the smaller campus allowed her to get to know everyone on a more personal basis.

Althea shares that her greatest accomplishments are when she sees her former students succeed in achieving their goals. While at Cañada, Althea has taught in the Paralegal Program, mentored students and helped them form professional alliances to further their careers. She also taught entrepreneurship courses at the downtown Redwood City location helping students with the legal aspects of forming a business. In 2018, she completely revised the Paralegal Program curriculum, making it more relevant to the needs of Silicon Valley employers. The Program was also moved online to increase accessibility and diversity. She has also created relationships with law libraries, law firms and corporate counsel to increase internship and employment opportunities for our students.

Althea's greatest discovery while at Cañada and SMCCCD is seeing how much everyone cares about helping the students succeed. She said it is also wonderful to work with people who bring so much knowledge and so many different experiences to Cañada College and the District. Althea greatly appreciates being part of this wonderful community!




Mario Peña, Accounting Technician, Administrative Services Division


Safety Committee Meeting
