# Please Share with Your Students: Verify Your Vaccination Status For Summer 2022 Registration

Please help spread the word: for students who plan to register for in-person, hybrid, or hyflex courses, or any on-campus programming or services, they will be required to submit proof of their COVID-19 Vaccination or apply for an exemption prior to registering, if they have not done so already. The deadline to verify their vaccination status for early registration is April 12, 2022, for Summer 2022 courses. If students have already submitted proof of their COVID-19 Vaccination, they do NOT need to re-submit. Students do not need to submit proof of a Booster vaccination. Please direct students to visit the <u>Return to Campus website</u> for instructions on how to verify their vaccination status or apply for an exemption. In addition, messages have been sent to students this week via Canvas and GWAMAIL/student email (please see copy of attached message).

Access will be very limited and is offered by reservation only, Tuesday & Thursday mornings from 8 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and 4 – 7 p.m. Reservations must be made in advance and can only be made with a CSM-Athletic Center Membership Number via the <u>membership website</u>.
