COVID-19 At-Home Antigen and Onsite Tests

This week, the District sent communication that we have received our first shipment of limited at-home antigen (rapid) testing kits. At this time, employees can request one test kit that contains two tests via their division office. Information will be provided about subsequent employee availability as supplies are received by the District. Information about student at-home testing kits will be provided soon. In addition, on February 22, employees, students and the broader community with or without symptoms can test via our partnership with COVID Clinic.
