Current students who need access to internet and technology equipment or software required to complete coursework, are eligible to borrow available equipment such as Chromebooks, hotspots and graphing calculators. We are proud to share that since August 1, 2020, Cañada has checked out 1,023 technology items to students, including laptops, Chromebooks, calculators and WiFi Hotspots. In addition, more than 500 Cañada College students have checked out one or more technology items in this time period. Since Spring 2020, the College has invested \$388,232 to acquire and support technology equipment for student use.
