Cañada in the Community

As part of an effort to integrate our Dual Enrollment students to our Cañada Campus, on March 17, a group of 18 Pescadero High School students and their High School Counselor, Margaret Sedillo, visited our college. Interim President Kim Lopez and Vice President of Student Services, Manuel Pérez personally welcomed the students to campus when they arrived. Pescadero High School students then learned about our Cañada College programs from Director of High School Transitions, Mayra Arellano and College Recruiter, Olivia Cortez-Figueroa. Afterwards, Professor and Cañada College Counselor, Daryan Chan who teaches Dual Enrollment class CRER 137 got to meet and speak with the students in person. Students also heard from Cañada College Student Ambassadors, Tivi and Joaquin, on why they each chose Cañada College. Students were then taken on a campus tour that started with a visit to the Education & Human Development and Digital Arts & Animation Departments. There, students heard from Dean Hyla Lacefield, Professors Paul Naas and Jamie Hui. Afterwards, students were taken to visit the Welcome Center, Financial Aid Office, Dream Center and EOPS, where they heard from staff about Cañada College programs. To round out the campus tour, students visited our new Kinesiology & Wellness Building. Cañada College looks forward to making this an annual event for Pescadero High School.



In addition, our Educators Now student club recently held a book reading of the “Adventures of the Mighty-Five: Fighting Corvin and His Creeps,” followed by a related activity, at the Redwood City Public Library! The event was well attended and children received a copy of the book as well as a balloon. The club is planning and hoping to publish printed copies of their accompanying workbook, as well as producing a Spanish version of the children’s book.
