- The campus community kicked off the new academic year with an inspiring College Opening Day.



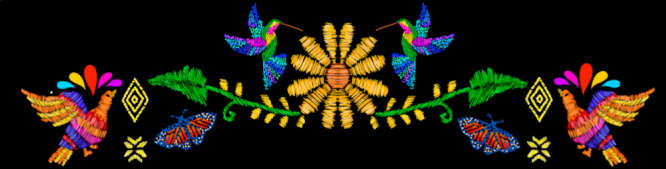
Cañada College and Pal Center Partner to Expand Youth Pathways
