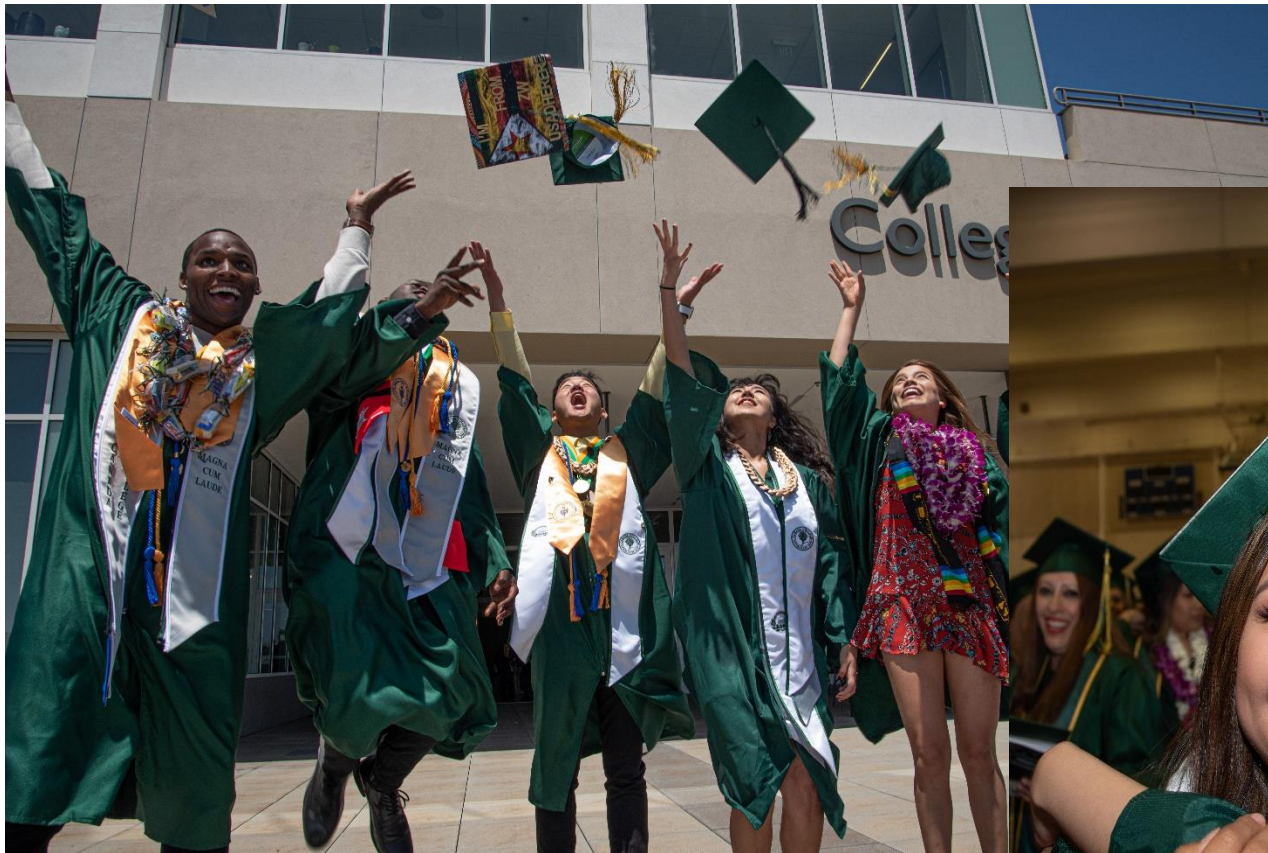


Class of 2019

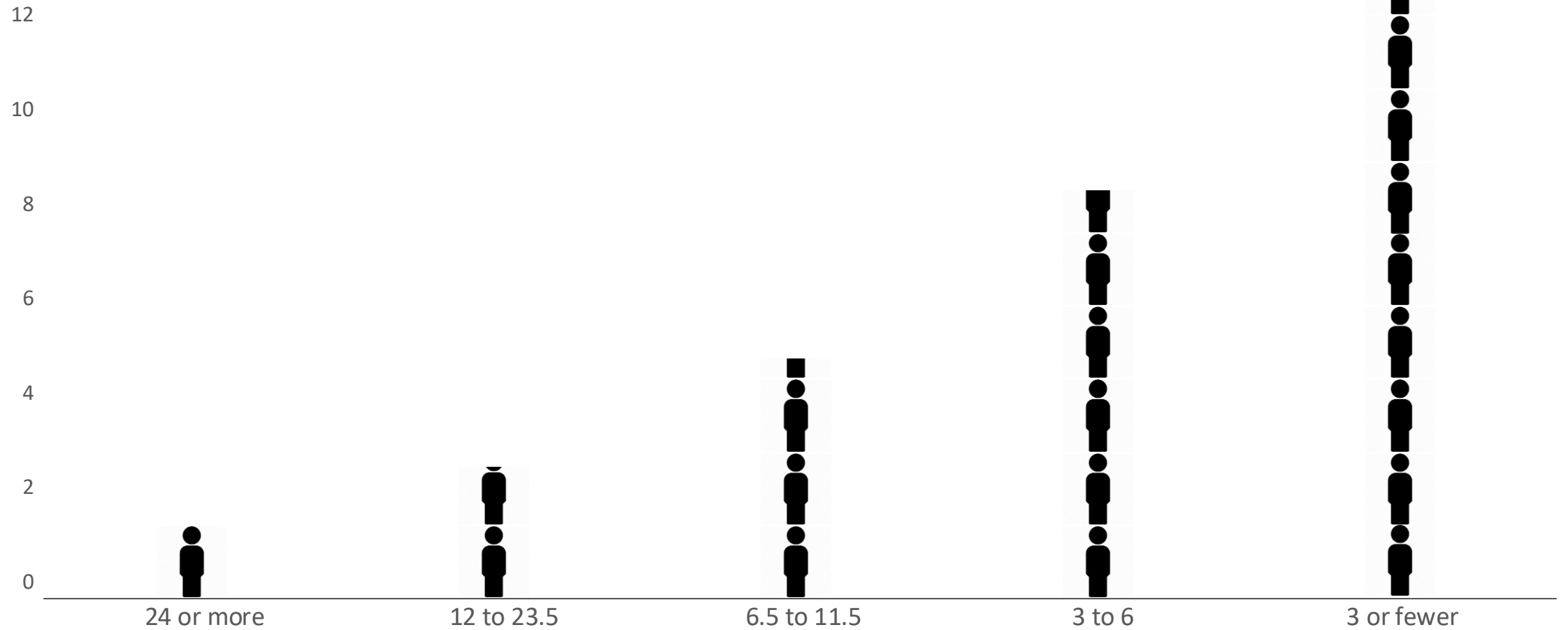

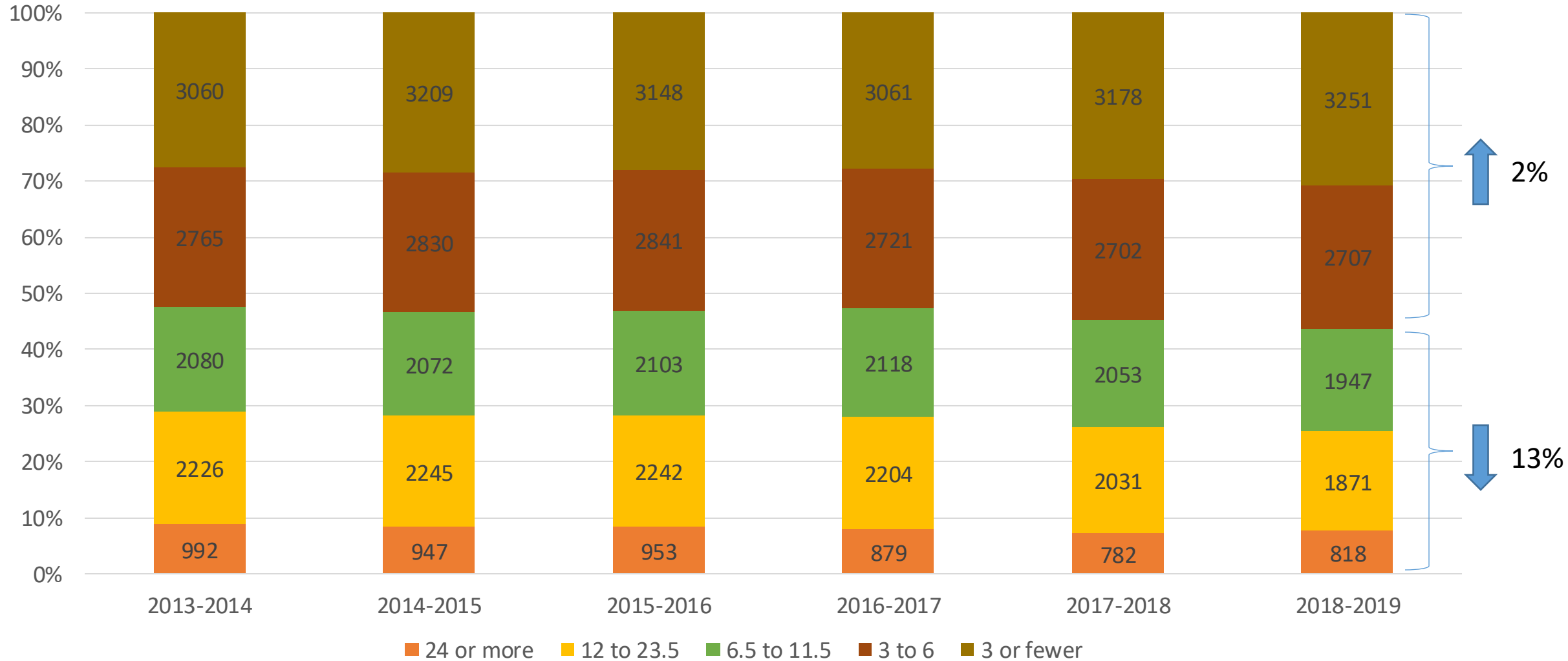
Cañada College Unique Headcount and Full Time Equivalent Students (FTES): 1999-2019
