

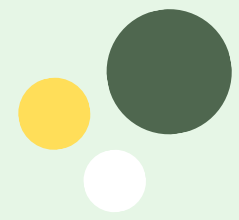

- Asian – 6 subgroups (including Asian others & Filipinx), Southeast Asian – 3 subgroups, Pacific Islander – 3 subgroups
  - Chinese and Filipinx being the 2 largest under the Asian umbrella
  - Vietnamese being the largest under the SE Asian umbrella)
  - Samoan being the largest population under the Pacific Islander umbrella
- 2023-2024 Pacific Islander have the lowest successful enrollment & 2nd highest withdrawal rate
- FilipinX identified as DI student population in the SEAP Plan 22-25.

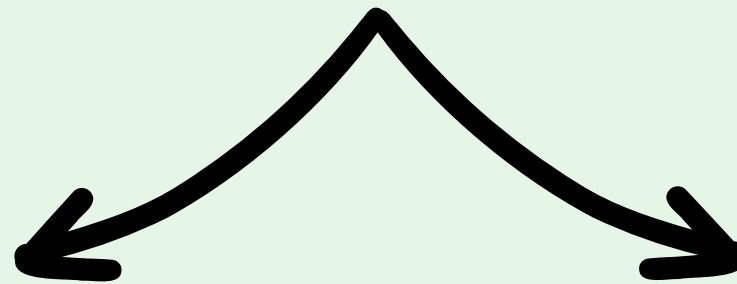
