### What are "institution-set standards"?

ACCJC Standard I.B.3 states: "The institution establishes institution-set standards for student achievement, appropriate to its mission, assesses how well it is achieving them in pursuit of continuous improvement, and publishes this information."

- Standards are the "floor" or minimum acceptable outcome
- Goals are what we are stretching or aspiring to achieve






### Students are back. FTES is lower than ever.




## Average units attempted per (all) student per academic year continues to decline

### Home Campus Students Slowly Recovering




# of SUHSD high school graduates who enroll at CAN within one year of graduation




# Enrolled in Middle College

In our EMP and new MOU with Sequoia Union HSD, we have a new goal of doubling the size of Middle College to 206 by 2027.




High Schoolers

#### Student Momentum: Persistence



#### Student Momentum: Course Success










### Average # units earned by associate earners




Average # units earned among students who earned their first associate degree in the selected year and had completed at least 60 units

### Average # units earned by associate earners




Average # units earned among students who earned their first associate degree in the selected year and had completed at least 60 units


### # of students completing degrees 100% online



# of students who transferred to a four-year institution who took at least 12 units at CAN in the year prior to transfer




# of students who transferred to a four-year institution who took at least 12 units at CAN in the year prior to transfer but who did not earn a degree




