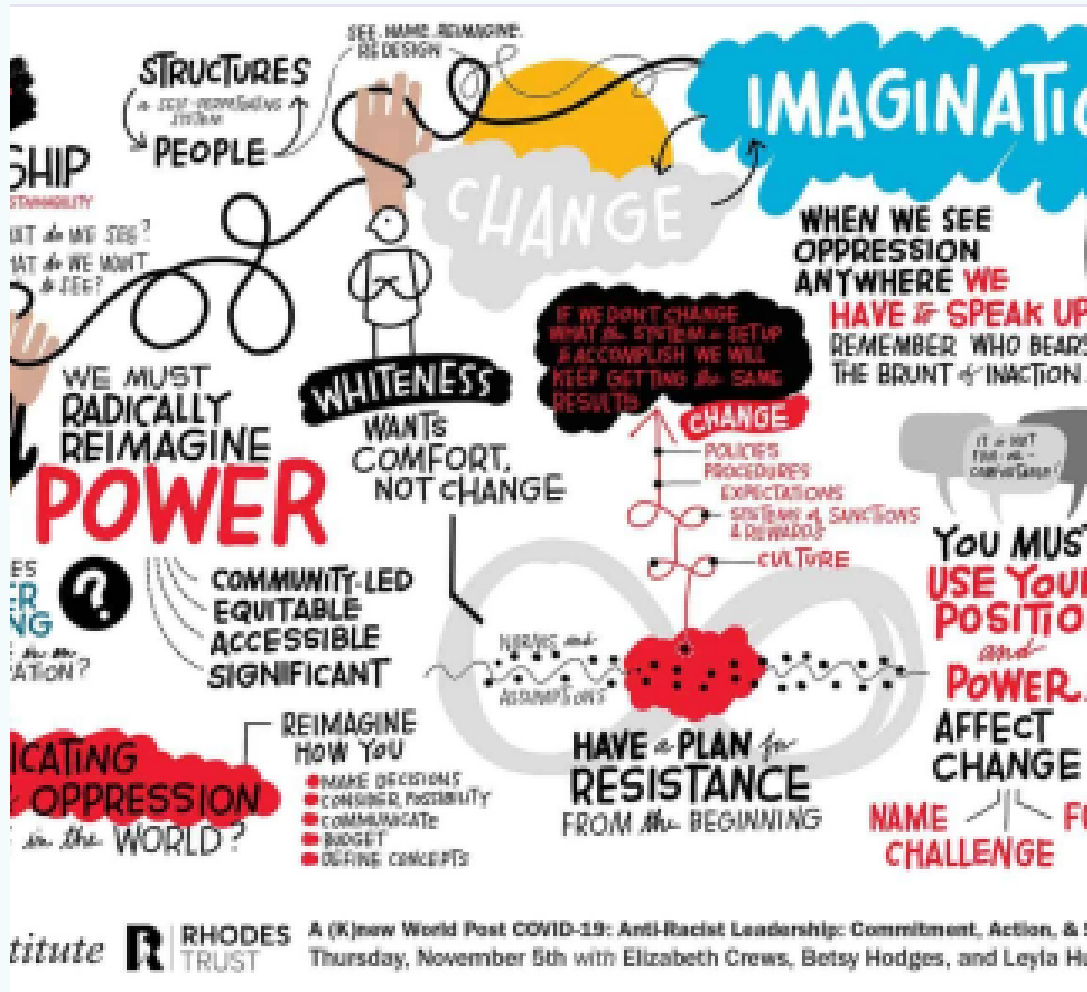
Embedding TAL principles ensures that program review questions promote equity, transparency, and systemic change.

Removing repetition makes the review process easier, faster, and more user-friendly.


Improved Clarity and Utility

Overview of the Updated Program Review Questions

1. **Comprehensive Program Review (CPR):** 23 questions total
Provides a full evaluation of program effectiveness, outcomes, equity, and resource needs across the full review cycle.
1. **Annual Update:** 7 questions selected from CPR
A shorter, focused update designed to maintain progress when requesting personnel and non-personnel resources
2. **Commitment on Program Review Questions**
Questions remain the same for 6 years or 2 cycles unless changes are required by accreditation or legal mandates.



Proposed Action: PBC approves SSPC's proposed changes to the Student Services CPR and Annual Update Questions.

Proposed Critical Question 1: How does this resource request support closing the equity gaps as identified in the current SEAP plan?

Critical Question 2 : How does this resource request support Latinx and AANAPISI students?

Proposed Critical Question 2 : How does this resource request support LatinX, AANHPI, and/or Black and African American students?
