

## PRIE Data Dashboard Dictionary

Cañada PRIE office Data Dashboard is composed by three data warehouses; *Dashboards with IDs Warehouse*, *Dashboards without IDs Warehouse*, and *STEM Warehouse*. It gives an opportunity to acquire desired student data by selecting a multitude of filters. Data can be filtered by college(s), registration term(s), division(s) and subjects(s) in any desired combination. In addition, multiple selections can be made in each category. The Dashboard also gives an opportunity to enter specific student populations by utilizing the “Load G Num’s” feature. After all initial selections are made data from the SMCCD warehouse is acquired by clicking on the “Load Data” tab. The Enrollment Warehouse Dashboard is by far the most utilized among the dashboards, it utilizes 50 different dimensions, each of which contains important characteristics pertaining to students who have records in the SMCCD. Descriptions of these characteristics and examples of the corresponding field values are given in the table below.
