

How to upload videos on YouTube for an Android phone

- Install the latest version of the YouTube app on your phone or tablet
- Sign into your YouTube Channel (this may be the same as a Gmail account, or you need to set up a YouTube account)
- Access Accounts and go to **My Channel > Videos**
- Tap on the small red button with a white arrow to upload a new video
- Choose the location the video is stored (gallery, Dropbox, GoogleDrive, etc.)
- Edit the video (the blue handles on the timeline allow you to trim the video)
- Choose a title
- Set the visibility options (Public, Unlisted, Private)
- Tap on the paper plane-shaped icon (top right) to upload the video.

How to upload videos on YouTube for an iPad or iPhone (method 1)

- Install the latest version of YouTube on your phone or tablet
- Sign into your YouTube Channel (this may be the same as a Gmail account, or you need to set up a YouTube account)
- Tap on the photos app
- Select the video to upload
- Tap the up Arrow-shaped Share icon on the bottom left corner of the screen
- Select YouTube from the share menu (if this is not part of the menu, click more)
- Create a title and brief description
- Set the visibility options (Public, Unlisted, Private)
- Tap Publish from the top right corner of your screen

How to upload videos on YouTube for an iPad or iPhone (method 2)

- Open the YouTube app on your phone or tablet
- Sign into your YouTube Channel (this may be the same as a Gmail account, or you need to set up a YouTube account)
- Tap on the video camera icon
- Tap **OK** for YouTube to have access to photos on your device
- Select the video you want to upload
- Edit the video by tapping the scissor icon in the bottom left corner of the screen (the blue handles on the timeline allow you to trim the video)
- Create a title and brief description
- Set the visibility options (Public, Unlisted, Private)
- Tap **Upload** from the top right corner of the screen

Adding subtitles and closed captions

- Log into YouTube using a tablet or computer
- Click **My Channel** in the menu on the left side of the page
- Select **Uploads** from the menu
- Choose the video to be captioned
- Select **Video Manager** below the video on the right
- Choose **Subtitles and CC** from the edit menu next to the video
- Click **Add new subtitles or CC** and choose the language for the subtitles
- Select the method for adding subtitles or closed captions
- Follow the directions for captioning using the selected method
- Check to make sure the captioning is accurate

Editing the video using a tablet or computer

- Log into YouTube using a tablet or computer
- Click **My Channel** in the menu on the left side of the page
- Select **Uploads** from the menu
- Choose the video to be edited
- Select **Video Manager** below the video on the right
- Choose **Create > Video Editor** in the menu on the left
- Drag the blue handles to trim the video (original video will remain saved to your channel)
- Click **Create Video**
