Land and Labor Acknowledgement			Hudson	4	2
We acknowledge that Cañada College is situated on the traditional unceded land of the Ramaytush (Rahmy-toosh) Ohlone (Oh-LOW-nee) peoples, and we respect our past elders and honor the present community. Long before Cañada College existed, this area was home to the Ramaytush Ohlone peoples, who still have a presence in the Bay Area today. We have a responsibility to acknowledge that we as a Cañada community have benefited from the use and occupation of this land and that the tragic legacy of colonization, genocide, capitalism, racism, and oppression still impacts people today. We also recognize the labor upon which this educational institution, state, and country is built. We acknowledge the peoples of African ancestry who were enslaved and forcibly brought to this land, and whose forced labor played a major role in the formation of this country. We are indebted to their uncompensated labor and their unwilling sacrifice over hundreds of years—which continues to impact generations today. We honor the legacy of the African diaspora and the continued contribution of their survivors. We acknowledge the contributions of all immigrant labor, forced labor, and undocumented people who contributed, and continue to contribute, to the building and feeding of this land. We acknowledge their immeasurable sacrifices and work that allow us to gather in this space today. Let us not forget. Let us honor and engage with the people who have stewarded and labored on this land for generations, and let us honor these truths—by taking responsibility as a college community to continually educate ourselves about these realities, to affirm our commitment to justice through continual action, and to protect and sustain this land.

Anonymously collecting stories from students, faculty, and staff about their experiences with public safety Title Nine and CARES.			
Cultural Center	Michiko	20	
Dr. Michiko, Director of Equity, shared her background and highlighted the Office of Equity's work, including the Cultural Center, Women of Color Collaborative, Brothers Achieving Milestones, LGBTQ+ support, equity trainings, and the \$1.8M Student Equity & Achievement Plan. The office also hosts over 100 events and 40 trainings annually and partners with nearly 200 organizations. Dr. Campo emphasized Student Senate's key role in equity planning, cultural programming, and curriculum advocacy. Discussion included the Office's role in curriculum change, support for disproportionately impacted students (first-gen, Black/African American, LGBTQ+), concerns about student safety and resources, and the importance of collaboration to strengthen persistence, transfer, and student success.
