□ Apply for UC TAG	After completing 30 UC transferrable units by the end of summer of the year you plan to file admission application: Fall Admission - in September/Spring Admission - in May
☐ Start drafting application essays/Personal Insight Questions	4-5 months before applying to University
☐ Apply to universities - after completing the major preparation courses, and the minimum admission requirements	 California State University Spring term: August 1 - 31/Fall term: Oct Nov. 30 University of California Fall term Nov. 1- 30/Winter/Spring term: July 1-31 Private and Out-of-State Universities - varies check their admission website
Apply for Financial Aid to attend 4-year university	Between October 1 and March 2
UC—Update your UC application online	Fall Admission: In January
CSU -Request and mail your transcript to CSU campuses	Winter / Spring Admission: October - November
Apply for housing at the university after you apply (If you are planning to live on campus)	February – April for Fall admission
(If you are planning to live on campus) ☐ Submit your Student Intent to Register (SIR)	October - November for Spring Admission For Fall Admission: May 1 for CSU; June 1 for UC, Private Universities/OOS varies: For Winter and Spring Admission: the deadline varies
□ Submit your final transcript - If applicable include IGETC/CSU GE Breadth Certification (some of the private universities may accept IGETC in place of their General Education)	July 1 for UC; July 15 for CSU Private Universities/Out-Of-State universities: varies
☐ Check your emails periodically to respond to any request from universities	As soon as you apply
☐ Register and attend the orientation at the university Some universities may also require a Writing Test	As scheduled by the universities
