 - Find financial resources and plan funding it

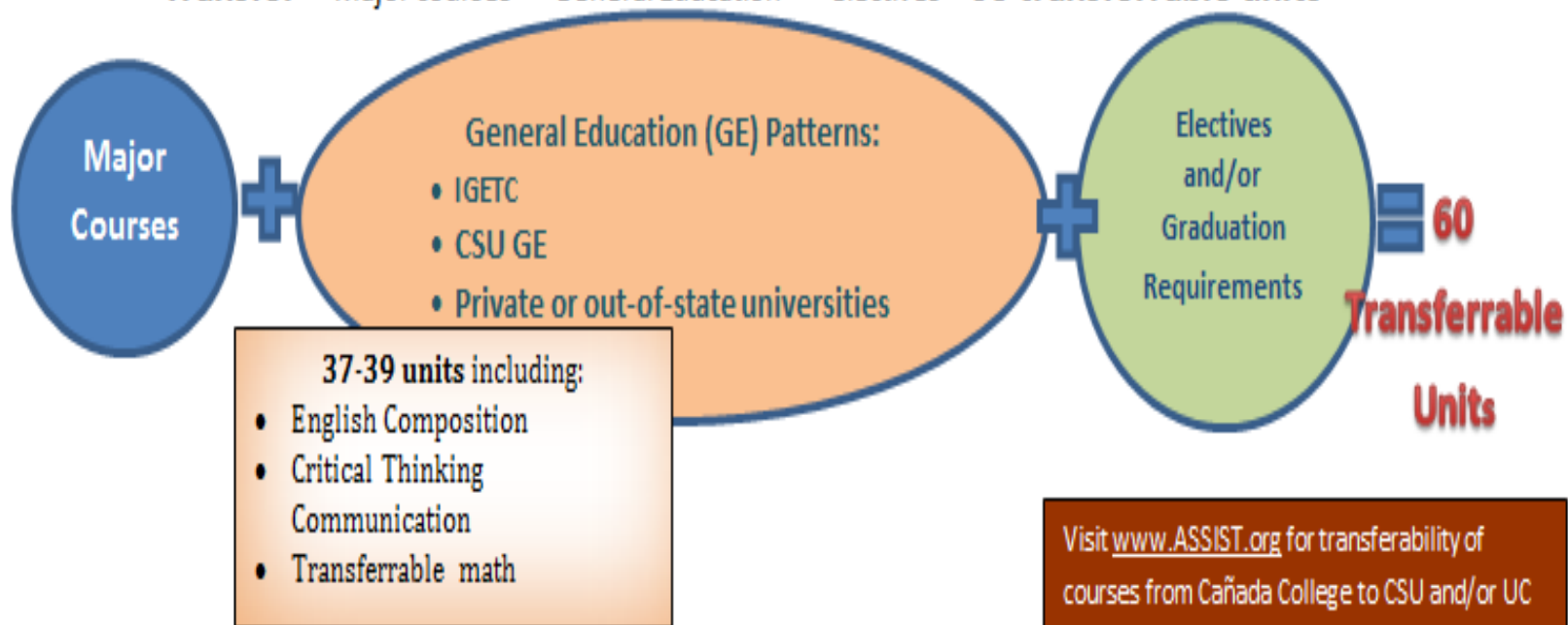
Transfer Options

- **University of California (UC)**
- **California State University (CSU)**
- **Private Universities**
- **Out-Of-State Universities**



Transferring to a CSU or UC

Transfer = Major courses + General Education + electives = 60 transferrable units



Transfer Option - UC

- 9 campuses – public institutions
- 60 transferrable units that includes:
 - English – math – Critical Thinking
 - Major prep.
 - IGETC (some program/campuses)/STEM IGETC
- GPA

Selective majors may require higher GPA and specific courses

Application submission period: November 1 - 30

Transfer Option - CSU

- There are 23 campuses – public institution
- 60 transferrable units that includes:
 - Completion of Golden 4 courses
 - English
 - Math
 - Oral Communication
 - Critical Thinking
 - Major prep.
- GPA

Application Submission period:

Fall term: October 1 – November 30

Winter term: June 1- 30

Spring term: August 1-31

Transfer Options

Private and Out-Of-State university

- Requirements varies
 - Minimum of 24-30 transferrable units
 - GPA varies

To apply go to www.Commonapp.org (most universities)

Application Requirements:

- Transcripts
- Essay/Personal Statement
- Recommendation Letter(s)
- ACT/SAT/TOEFL

Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE):

A fee reduction program among colleges and universities in Western states

Transfer Opportunities

Transfer Admission Guarantee (**TAG**)

- Early review of your academic records
 - Early admission notification
 - Guidance and Support from UC
 - Guaranteed admission to one of the UC campuses
-
- 6 campuses offer TAG
 - 30 transferrable units completed
 - Apply between September 1 -30 of the same year you plan to apply

Transfer Opportunities



Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

- An agreement between Community Colleges and CSU
- A path to CSU campuses
- Priority admission to CSU Campuses
- Only 60 transferrable units (major + GE + electives) – including 12 Transfer units at Cañada

Benefits of completing an ADT:

- Receive an Associate Degree, complete CSU GE certification, and transfer requirements
- Receive local CSU admission priority
- Following the same requirement for all CSU Campuses

Other Benefits...

- Spring Admission to CSU campuses (selected campuses – see after June 1st www.calstate.edu/apply)
- Redirect to an alternate CSU Campus if not accepted to the campus of choice
- Will facilitate the transfer process to a CSU campus that there is no major course articulated
- GPA Bump

Associate for Transfer A path to CSU

AA-T/AS-T Degree Requirements:

Need total 60 units that includes:

- Major Courses
- CSU GE breadth or IGETC
- File a AA-T/AS-T degree petition by the deadline
- Apply to CSU by the deadline
- Obtain a degree verification letter from Transfer Center and submit it to CSU

ADT Degree vs. Local Degree

AA-T/AS-T Degrees:

Requires 60 CSU transferrable units that includes:

- CSU GE or IGETC
- Major courses
- Electives if needed

Local AA/AS degrees:

- 60 degree applicable (majority of the courses will also transfer to CSU)
- Students must complete all the local Associate degree requirements

Honors Transfer Program

- Priority admission to universities through the [Honors Transfer Council of California](#)
- Priority admission to UCLA and UC Irvine
- Opportunity for a research projects and to present at Honors Symposium
- Enhance the Scholarship opportunities
- More.....

Requirements:

- Have a high school GPA of 3.5 or College GPA of 3.3
- Be eligible for English 100 and MATH 125, 130, 140, 200, 222, 241, or 251.

Completion of the Program = Completing 15 units of honors courses

Deadline to apply:

Fall 2017: **Sept. 30, 2017**

Spring 2018: **March 4, 2018**

Transfer Opportunities

Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU)

This is an agreement between California Community Colleges and HBCU to ease the transfer process.

there are 35 HBCU campuses that offer Guarantee admission to California Community College students.

Requirements

Before applying, students must have:

- Completed 30 UC or CSU transferable units, or an Associate Transfer degree
- A 2.5 or higher GPA
